TO MAKE DISCIPLES	<p><b>WORSHIP</b></p> <p>ENHANCE and improve our worship spaces and liturgies</p>	1	Evaluate all worship services (Sunday morning and other) in terms of addressing our WHY - "to make disciples"
		2	Engage in a lighting, sound, technology, and aesthetic assessment of worship spaces
		3	Develop a non-static worship design team to explore ways to make Traditional Worship more "Ancient/Future" worship (smells & bells, liturgical movement, chanting)
		4	Develop a non-static worship design team to explore ways to make Contemporary Worship more "Experiential" (prayer stations, metaphor based, original liturgies)
		5	Increase lay participation in worship leadership
	<p>Explore ways to CONNECT the other priority spiritual practices through share worship experiences</p>	6	Emphasize sermon as "connecting tool" between and among other priority spiritual disciplines. This includes developing sermon series and/or other means to encourage discussion & reflection among the congregation
		7	Develop alternative worship experiences to connect with wider community (ie. Blessing of the Animals, Election Night Communion, Soccer Fields, Xmas tree lighting)
	<p>Emphasize the ENCOUNTER with God and with others</p>	8	Develop opportunities in worship specifically for children and students
		9	Enhance ministries of hospitality and welcome around worship times & spaces
		10	Evaluate process & placement of greeting time and prayer concerns in all services
	<p>TELL stories</p>	11	Celebrate anecdotal stories/ministries/events/personal experiences in worship
		12	Incorporate "story telling" (live/recorded/electronic) in sermons
		13	Tell stories through music

			17 Develop Children/Student versions of Prayer Guidebook/Retreats as appropriate
	MODEL diverse prayer styles & PRACTICE daily in all settings	18 Incorporate (and name) different styles of prayer in all worship, meeting, small group and special event gatherings	
		19 Create study & exploration opportunities of prayer styles & practice using Prayer Guidebook	
		20 Create "Daily Reminders" - to pray & specific prayer requests	
		21 Explore using technology to enhance daily practice (Google hang-outs, Periscoping, etc.)
