## ON-CAMPUS MISSIONS

### Latino Family Center Summer Camp

#### **1. Child's summer camp scholarship for 1 week \$50**

The Latino Family Center provides a two-week day camp for English-as-a-Second-Language children on the campus of Wesley Memorial. Your scholarship gift pays camp expenses for one child for one week.

### Minister's Discretionary Fund

#### **2. Emergency funds for people in need \$25**

Each week, people in need come to Wesley Memorial's doors needing help with electric bills, rent, fuel for their cars, medicines, and food. This fund assists people needing emergency financial assistance and gives them a measure of hope.

### Prayer Shawl Ministries

#### **3. Yarn for prayer shawls or Victory Junction afghans \$25**

The Prayer Shawl Ministry has provided more than 1,000 shawls, blankets, lap robes, scarves, caps, and sweaters for Hospice patients, critically ill children, and others who are in need. Your gift purchases enough yarn to make a shawl, blanket, or several smaller items.

### Through-the-Week Preschool

#### **4. Toward scholarship for 1 child \$25**

The Through-The-Week program has a long history of excellence in pre-school education for children. The TTW Scholarship Fund pays tuition for qualifying young children to participate in this excellent program.

### **Way Station After-School Care**

#### **5. Snacks, transportation, or scholarship for 1 child \$25**

The Wesley Memorial Way Station offers after-school child care, providing a safe and loving environment for children between the end of the school day and time to go home. Your gift goes toward snacks, fuel for the van that picks up the children from school, or tuition.

## **LOCAL MISSIONS**

### **Community Clinic of High Point**

#### **6. Diabetes medication for 1 month \$50**

Many of the patients who seek care at the Community Clinic of High Point are diabetics who cannot afford the basic medication to manage their disease. Your gift will provide that medication for one month.

#### **7. Blood pressure medication for 1 month \$25**

Affordability is one of the primary reasons indigent patients don't follow their medication instructions. Your gift purchases a month's supply of blood pressure medicine, one of the most needed at the Community Clinic.

### **Bereavement Ministries**

#### **8. Care box of supplies for bereaved family \$15**

A care box of needed supplies – paper plates, cutlery, napkins, towels, Kleenex, aluminum foil, and garbage bags – accompanies a meal prepared for a bereaved family.

### **Fairview Elementary School Partnership**

#### **9. Weekend backpack with nonperishable foods \$25**

For the majority of Fairview students, the most basic food staples are few and far between. Each backpack is filled with non-perishable food items for one student over a long weekend or extended school break.

### **High Point Jail Ministry**

#### **10. Bible and study materials for 1 inmate \$10**

Provide a Bible and study materials for an inmate in the High Point Jail so he or she can learn about God's Word while in jail and continue spiritual growth upon release. Wesley Memorial's Jail Ministry Team leads adult Bible studies each Tuesday and Sunday evenings.

#### **11. Socks and underwear for 1 inmate \$10**

Buy socks and underwear, and meet a most basic need for an inmate at the High Point Jail. Our Jail Ministry Team helps meet the physical and spiritual needs of this often overlooked segment of our society.

**Macedonia Family Resource Center**

**12. Little League baseball equipment \$10**

The center sponsors 12 Little League baseball teams serving 180 inner-city children. Your gift will help supply bats, balls, gloves, and uniforms.

**13. Macedonia Moms \$10**

Macedonia Moms helps women become more self-sufficient through mentoring, Bible studies, and an emphasis on missions – giving to others as God has given to them. Their weekly lunch meetings include time to work on projects that benefit others in need.

**Matthew's Shelter**

**14. Materials toward a new home for qualified family \$25**

While many families are able to receive help toward a new home, some hardworking families fall through the cracks. Your gift purchases materials for building a new home for a qualified family through this special ministry.

**Mobile Meals**

**15. Hot meal for home-bound High Pointer \$5**

Operated completely by volunteers, Mobile Meals delivers hot, nutritious meals each weekday to 165 people unable to prepare their own meals. Your gift provides one hot meal for a person in need.

**Open Door Sandwich Ministry**

**16. 1 lunch each for 2 homeless people \$10**

Wesley Memorial furnishes and delivers bagged lunches to 150 or so homeless men, women, and children on the fourth Sunday of each month. Your gift purchases two bag lunches, each of which includes two sandwiches, chips, fruit, a cookie, napkin, condiments, and a drink.

**Southern Triad Missions at Ward Street**

**17. A week of food staples for family of four \$25**

Southern Triad Missions, created as a non-profit organization to seek grant funding, operates a food pantry and other special assistance at Ward Street Mission. Your gift supplies a week of food staples for a needy family.

**18. Contribute toward utilities and heat for 1 family \$25**

Qualifying Ward Street families are offered assistance by Southern Triad Missions with their costs for heat and utilities in their homes.

**Ward Street Mission programs**

**19. Sponsor youth for church camp, retreat,  
or leadership academy \$15**

Spiritually nurturing programs are all integral to the success of a church's youth ministry. The members of Ward Street Mission don't have extra money to devote to these enriching experiences. Your gift will help make God's love real for these growing Christians.

**20. Bible for Naaman Men's Recovery House \$25**

Naaman Men's Recovery House is a faith-based, residential addiction-recovery program sponsored by Ward Street Mission. Your gift will provide a New Life Recovery Bible for a study that includes follow-up homework, a 12-step program, and work. Ward Street is seeking 30 Bibles for this program.

**West End Ministries**

**21. Overnight lodging and food for 1 homeless woman  
at Leslie's House \$10**

Give one woman lodging, a meal, and toiletry supplies for the night at Leslie's House, a shelter for High Point's homeless women. While there, women are given encouragement and guidance to leave life on the street.

**22. Uniform and supplies for Boy Scout \$10**

Your gift will help provide a uniform, equipment, and camping and meeting supplies for one child participating in a Scout Troop for neighborhood boys.

## GLOBAL MISSIONS

**Henderson Settlement (Ky.)**

**23. Food box for a family for 1 month \$35**

A mission agency of the United Methodist Church, the Henderson Settlement seeks to meet basic needs for families in this impoverished, isolated community. Your gift supplies staples for a deserving family.

**24. Wood for winter fuel for 1 family \$45**

A load of firewood promises a degree of warmth and comfort to get a family through the cold winter months in the Appalachian Mountains.

**Maua, Kenya****25. Life-saving immunizations for Wesley Clinic \$10**

The Wesley Memorial Clinic in Ndoleli is in a rural, poverty-stricken area, and many patients here cannot afford the medication necessary to treat their illnesses. Your gift will purchase immunizations and medications for malaria, skin diseases, and childhood disorders.

**26. Water filter for schools, clinics, or homes \$65**

These sand filters are constructed at the Maua Methodist Hospital to be placed at schools, clinics, homes, and other locations. The filters purify the water and reduce the incidence of intestinal worms and other bacteria-related diseases. The cost includes filter manufacture, delivery, and setup.

**Nakuru, Kenya****27. Chicks and feed \$5**

Each \$5 gift purchases two baby chicks and their feed for six months, providing a Nakuru woman with a way to help support her family. As the chickens grow, they will produce eggs that provide both food and income.

**28. Squatters Hill: Lunch for 50 children for 1 week \$25**

The children who forage at the Squatters Hill slum near Nakuru are in desperate need of nourishment. A gift of \$25 provides a lunch of rice and beans to 50 children for one week.

**Maua and Nakuru, Kenya****29. 1 goat for Goat Herd Project \$165**

Establish a herd of milk-producing goats to provide food and income for needy families. Goat milk is easily digested by small children and people with compromised immune systems. The program is modeled after the Heifer Project and uses the Kenyan Department of Agriculture as a consultant.

**St. Croix****30. Raise the church roof \$25**

Each year, a team of Wesley Memorial members has helped local residents to repair and rebuild their churches. Your gift will assist with the purchase of necessary roof-building materials.
