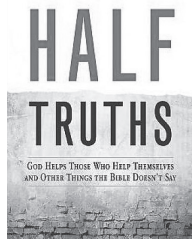

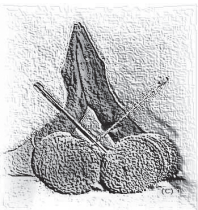
### MONTHLY FOOD DISTRIBUTION PROCESS FEEDS THOSE IN NEED
