VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED FOR THE PILLOW MINISTRY

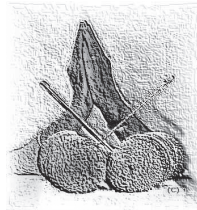
