LENTEN DEVOTIONAL COLORING PAGES AVAILABLE AT THE FRONT DESK

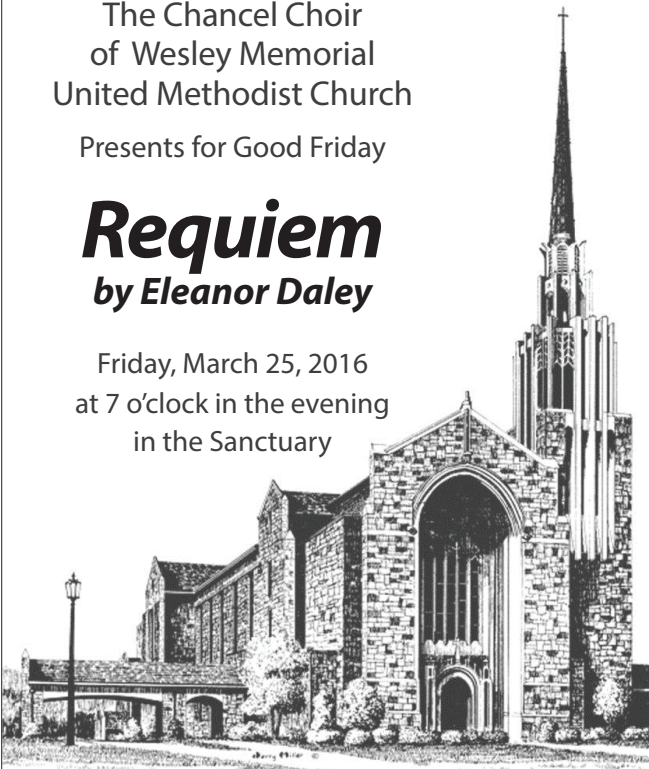

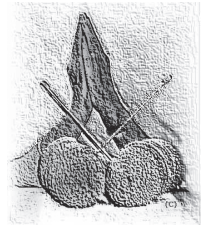
