SPECIAL SUNDAY SCHOOL EVENT ON THE FIFTH SUNDAY: MAY 29

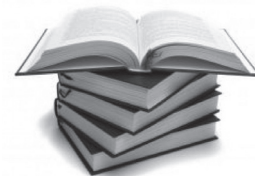
