DR. EFIRD LECTURE SERIES CONTINUES FOR THE NEXT THREE MONDAY NIGHTS

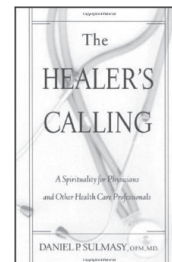

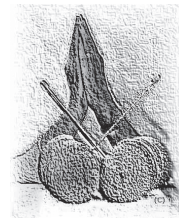
