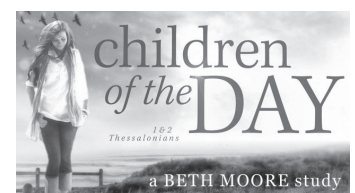


JOIN DR. MICKEY EFIRD FOR A NEW STUDY
