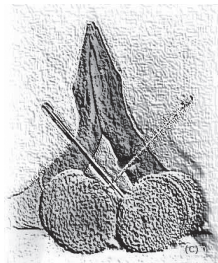


#### HELPERS NEEDED TO PREPARE LOVEFEAST CANDLES
